

ABOUT THE CONGRESS



The International Equine Infectious Diseases conference (IEIDC) is held every four years and brings together researchers, veterinarians, and scientists from all around the world to discuss the latest developments in infectious diseases of horses.

This is an important conference for those of us who work in this field, as it is the only conference focused on the horse and the infectious diseases that affect them. Infectious diseases cause serious health and welfare problems for horses across the globe. Horses and other equids are widely used in developing countries for transport of people and goods, and horse transportation has increased over the years as more sport horses are moved for competition across the world. Both of these situations have their own unique infectious disease problems, and these will be addressed in the sessions on working equids and international horse movement at IEIDC 2024 in Deauville.

The IEIDC brings people from all infectious disease disciplines: parasitology, bacteriology, virology, as well as immunologists and other experts in horse health. The goal of this meeting is to share our knowledge, and to build better collaborative relationships to address the infectious disease problems that affect the wellbeing of horses around the world.

It is the quality and diversity of the science that makes this conference so attractive to delegates. The high quality of the scientific programme at our last three conferences in 2012 (Lexington), 2016 (Buenos Aires) and 2021 (on-line event) has been the reason for the high attendance achieved. However, the thing I like best about this conference is meeting new people who share my passion for horses and infectious diseases and having the opportunity to spend time with old friends, some of whom I met at my first IEIDC in 1998 when I attended as a PhD student.



-  Entrance to main auditorium


Provisional exhibitory map

IEIDC VENUE

IEIDC 2024 will be held at the Deauville International Center from 30th September to 4th October, 2024

The Deauville International Center (CID) hosts about 160 events every year, the most renowned one being the American Film Festival.

The CID offers first-class facilities to organize a large international conference like IEIDC : big auditorium, numerous conference rooms, and exhibition halls.

TRAVEL TO CAEN AND/OR DEAUVILLE

Deauville is located in the region of Normandy and lies approximately 50km (31 miles) from Caen and 250km (150miles) west of Paris.

By plane: Paris airports and two airports nearby (Caen Carpiquet & Deauville Normandie)

By car: at approximately 250 km (150 miles) west of Paris, with an average time less than 2:30 h from Paris airports (Charles de Gaulle or Orly) via the A13 Highway (toll of 11.70 €)

By bus: the bus company Ouibus operates during the summer direct lines between Paris and Deauville, for 18-20 € (single ticket)

By train: around two hours from Paris St-Lazare with direct Intercités trains to Deauville-Trouville or Caen stations.

TRAVEL AND TRANSPORTATION

How to reach Gare Saint-Lazare from Paris airports ?

From Charles De Gaulle Airport to St-Lazare train station (around 50 min) :

Take the RER B (south bound) and step out at «Gare du Nord». Change to the RER E which will take you to Saint-Lazare station in just one stop (and at no extra cost - the transfer is included in your ticket from the airport). The fare will be about 9€.

From Orly Airport to St-Lazare train station (around one hour) :

Take the Orlyval shuttle to the «Antony» RER B station.

From there take any train in the direction of «Mity-Claye» or «Aéroport-CDG» and exit at «Châtelet-les-Halles» station.

Transfer to the Métro Line 14 to go to Gare St Lazare. The fare will be around 10€.

Taxis are also available for a fare of around 60€.



Transportation in the City

Deauville has no public transport network. However, considering its size, you can easily walk around the town without tiring yourself. You can also rent a bike since Deauville is small and flat, perfect for cycling. If you want to visit the entire Calvados, the Bus Verts can take you to more than 100 Norman Towns.

Car parks in Deauville

The roadside parking areas are divided into 4 zones. As for car parks, you can choose between the one near the harbour or the market. Prices vary according to the option you choose and you can check the price list. Parking lots are also available at the CID and nearby for a daily rate of around 22€.
